We are due for the reaccreditation of our Swim 21 Learn to swim. Previously, we were awarded the Aquamark Premier Status and upgraded to the new swim 21 learn to swim status. This is approval by the ASA that our swimming programme meets the industry standards and we are the **only club in the country** to have completed this whilst also holding the Swim 21 teaching accreditation for swimming clubs.
